## March is Missions Month

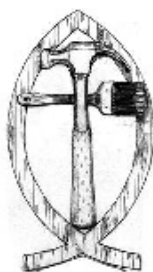

## The Shamrock and The Trinity



The shamrock was used by Saint Patrick to instruct about the Trinity. He would ask, "Is it one leaf or three?" His followers would respond, "It is one." Then he'd declare, "So it is with God!"

God is described with different words in the Bible, a few of which translate into English as LORD, Lord, the LORD almighty, God, God Almighty and so forth. When reading these in different places in the Bible, you become aware that although God is "one" He is also "more than one"—God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit (Holy Ghost). Together, they are referred to as "the Trinity" or "the Godhead." On this page we will provide explanations that help people understand God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and the Trinity.

God is not so complex that He can not be understood. The Bible is written so that anyone can understand Him. The difference is that God is not human, so *He can not be described as a human can be described*. The gods of every other religion can be described in "normal" terms since they were invented in the minds of men. Even some "Christians" invent their own description of God and make Him seem like these other gods (by denying the aspect of the Trinity).

The explanation of the Trinity is so simple that most people miss it.

- If God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit were the same, they would not have different names.
- If they were the same, they would not appear separately as they do in Matthew 3:16,17.
- In spite of being different, they are "one." (John 10:30)

So we understand that the three "members" of the Trinity are different, but have the same purpose (and they are all God).

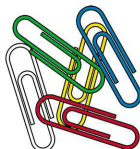

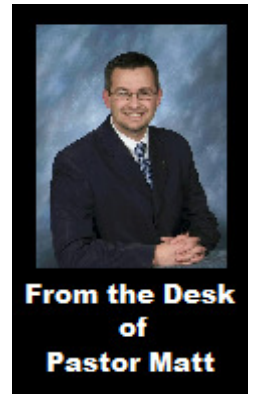

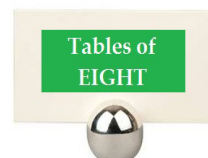

## Our Mission Statement

A pamphlet from our archives which shares the origin of Baptist International Missions, Inc. entitled "Beginning of Miracles" issued a statement of purpose and a "Call To Arms" that still speaks truth to us today: it stated...

It is our determination to continue as we have been doing through the years in **maintaining a strong scriptural basis, a world-wide outreach, and a complete commission in that we are to win souls to Christ and organize them into strong local churches...** As long as we stay in this path and take a strong stand against compromising theological trends, we will have the blessings of God and His grace will be upon us. We know that we are living in critical days, just prior to the coming of our Lord Jesus.

God help us to be faithful in our practice, fervent in our preaching, and dedicated to the task.

BIMI is committed to keeping the main thing the main thing: The Great Commission of Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:18-19). As the Church labors to fulfill this standing order, BIMI yields its resources in an effort to aid local churches in their labor to send missionaries to the field of God's calling. These "sent ones" stand in the gap and perform the work of the local church on the foreign mission field by evangelizing the lost through clear presentations of the Gospel in a culturally relevant fashion. Once a nucleus of baptized believers is developed, it can be organized into a local, autonomous Baptist church. National leadership is trained to lead this newborn church in spiritual growth and maturity. This is accomplished through Bible colleges and institutes where pastors and lay leaders are equipped to assume leadership roles.

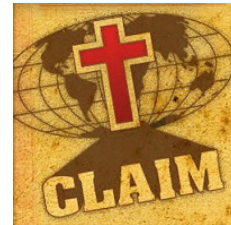

- There are only about 5,000 Independent Baptist Missionary families serving on foreign fields

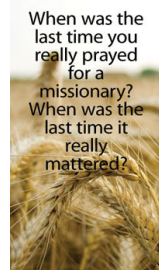

## Can the World be Reached in Our Lifetime?

Christ started with 12 disciples (students). Those twelve men took Christ's words to the world, city by city and turned it "upside down" (Acts 17:6).

If every Christian, who has truly repented of their sins, and asked Jesus to save them, would become a committed servant of Jesus going and telling anyone who will listen about Jesus, then the world could be turned to Christ in just 65 years. Watch the math:

**Year 1** - You get saved and into a Bible preaching church, and get discipled (taught the Bible). You start with 2 (you and your Discipled) - that's all you need!

**Year 3** - You finish being discipled, and then win someone else to Christ, and get them into church, and training them. Your previous discipled also goes and wins someone to Christ, and starts discipled them. *Now there are 4 Christians.*

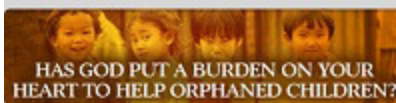
**Year 5** - You encourage your discipled to reproduce himself, and you go and get another person saved, and in discipleship. There would then be 8 Christians. Not a lot to show for 5 years, but watch.

**Year 7** - With everybody winning and training just one person, There would by now be 16, strong, dedicated, Christians who would be the basis for a very strong and vibrant church, reaching out and affecting the world for Christ!

This goes on with every Christian, every two years winning someone to Christ, training them in the Bible, and then encouraging them to win someone and train them, and so on, until **year 65**, when 8,589,934,592 will have been reached! That's 2 billion more than the current population!

**Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.**

Our missionaries are primarily church planters, but in that process God opens the door to rescue children from a wretched street life and often total rejection from society. Many of our missionaries have and are reaching out with compassion to children "in their affliction" in the countries where they serve.

For over 50 years Baptist International Missions, Inc. has endeavored to be faithful to the wishes of its donors. When your heart is burdened to send financial support for a missionary ministry it becomes our burden to ensure that your funds go where you want them to go.

Your monthly support or one time gift can help feed, clothe and shelter a needy orphan child. You can fulfill the admonition that James 1:27 gives us to visit (i.e., pay attention to) the fatherless by financially helping an orphanage ministry. **Through BIMI you have full assurance your donation will go to the orphanage on the specific field you are burdened to support.**

- ✓ Sign up for prayer letters/email updates/prayer cards, etc.
- ✓ Pray for missionaries regularly as a part of family devotions.
- ✓ Have missionaries in your home whenever possible.
- ✓ Talk about missions and missionaries with your kids!
- ✓ Read missionary biographies as a family.
- ✓ Foster strong relationships between your kids and the MKs.
- ✓ Consider a trip as a family to a mission field to learn and serve!
- ✓ Serve as a family, while asking God to use you in greater ways, including the possibility of actually *becoming* missionaries!!

## Responsibilities of the Sending Church

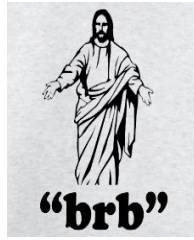
"What are the responsibilities of the sending church?" We know that every church should pray for and, in every way possible, take care of their missionaries. But, practically, how can that be done?

Here is a list of some valuable things that some sending churches are doing that other churches could do for their missionaries:

1. Provide the funds needed to take a survey trip to the field of their calling.
2. Provide for the expenses of candidate school.
3. Provide for the equipment needed to begin deputation:
  - Prayer cards
  - Brochures
  - Letterhead and stationary
  - Display board
  - Slide projector and presentation
4. Provide housing while they are on deputation.
5. Provide phone services. This is one of the most expensive areas of the missionary's deputation. If the sending church would allow their missionary to use the church phone, it would save the missionary literally hundreds of dollars.
6. Provide an office at the church. This would build more of a sense of accountability in the missionary to the sending church.
7. Support their own missionaries substantially more than they would missionaries from outside their church.
8. Allow the missionaries to be covered by their church staff insurance while on deputation.
9. Provide a vehicle or an automobile maintenance program.
10. Contact other pastors and urge them to allow the missionaries to come to their churches for the purpose of deputation.
11. Maintain regular contact with the missionary on deputation.

These are just a few suggestions. But, let us remember that statistically, the missionaries that have the greatest success in their deputation ministry and ultimately on the field are the ones that have the support and help of their sending church. Perhaps no church could do all of these, but if a sending church would pray and do as much for the missionary as it possibly can, it would certainly speed deputation.

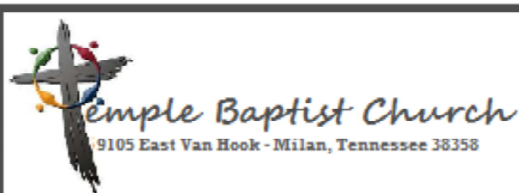
